Committee Purpose

- Simplify the stipend pay system for everyone
- Update the system (20+ years old)
- Address equity issues
- Implement new system in Fall of 2018
- Continue fiscal responsibility by maintaining the
 2016-17 budget as negotiated

Committee Process

- 10 meetings, 3 hours each
- Met from March, 2017 through March, 2018
- Analyzed systems and data from 10 other districts
- Discussed equity and systems issues
- Used data from the 2016-2017 school year

Stipend Facts

- SLCUSD pays over 600 stipends annually
- Includes <u>all</u> stipends regardless of funding source:
 - Elementary Stipends
 - Secondary Athletics
 - Secondary Activities

Stipends are not calculated based on an hourly rate

Amount expended in 2016-17 per SLO county districts

Factors Considered

- Stipends are for time outside the work day or personal time within the school day
- Prep time within the school day was outside the scope
- Stipend amount compared to other districts
- Positions, not people or performance
- Current stipend amount paid in SLCUSD

Developing a System

We created a system that:

- Is streamlined for stakeholders to understand easily
- Maintains equity between sites and activities
- Allows for site flexibility
- Increases only through the negotiations process

Examples of Equity Issues

Dept. Chair (same dept.)	\$2,267	\$1,170
HS Activity (same activity)	\$726	\$2,722
HS Varsity Coach (same sport)	\$5,625	\$3,629

Questions Asked

- How much time does this take beyond the expected work hours? (Prep time, breaks, lunch, after school...)
- How much do other districts pay for this work?
- How much are our current employees getting paid?
- Is our pay equitable between sites and positions?

Elementary Stipends

Elementary School Stipends

- 50% increase per school (\$8 per ADA to \$12 per ADA)
- Kept the site level flexibility to determine activities and their importance
- No change to combo class stipends (\$3,000) or Teacher in Charge (\$250)
- Field trip stipend (site funded and only at a few schools); can be taken from overall allocation
- Elementary Principals will develop suggested guidelines for stipends

Secondary Stipends

Secondary Athletic Stipends

- 175+ athletic stipends paid annually
- Supports 130+ teams at the secondary level
- 2,431 spots for secondary students on a sports team
- Over 30 sports district-wide

Rules for Implementation

- Extra duty pay is for coordinating school sports teams, serving on student focused committees, and facilitating student competitions, events, and activities
- Stipends may be shared between 2 people performing one duty/job - not more
- Partial stipends may be offered to part time coaches or directors (20% = one day per week)
